

Growing Paulownia from Seed

You will receive a quantity of the seed, at least that shown on the seed count on the listing, together with some of the seed case material. It is impossible to clean this out without losing most of the seed which is why I do not try.

Sow on the surface of a free draining compost, water well and seal. Germinate at 18 – 22 Deg C. Germination is quite rapid (14 -35 days). Do not exclude light.

Grow on in airy conditions, shading from direct sunlight. Pot on individually when large enough to handle and continue to grow on.

Although hardy, they are best grown under cover for their first winter, either in a cold frame or an unheated greenhouse. Plant out to their final positions in May/June of their second year.
